Aims:

The purpose of the group is to provide a safe space for you to swap ideas, seek assistance and pose queries and any challenges you'd like to hear from other members on.

Rules:

While we don't want to police this group, we do ask that you do keep the following guidelines in mind:

- **All views and opinions are accepted, unless they are of a deliberate hurtful, offensive or illegal nature, i.e.:**
 - Attacking individuals or groups.
 - Derogatory, or disrespectful
 - Obscene, objectionable, or in violation of any UK laws
 - Infringing on intellectual property, privacy or other rights of third parties;
- **Keep posts to the purpose of the group.** While we love a cat picture, please do try and use the group for all things related to the refugee and asylum sector. This also includes avoiding posting self-promotional messages and of an advertising nature.

- **Before sharing something, please check that it is a genuine link or message.**
- **Try to avoid long 1:1 conversations in the group.** Please switch to private messages if you want to specifically talk to one person.
- **Lastly, be respectful of other members' opinions.** As long as the opinions, views and debates are not threatening, everyone is entitled to express themselves - even if you disagree!
